



Asthma Policy

- Immediate access to reliever medicines is essential. Pupils with asthma are encouraged to carry their reliever inhaler as soon as the parent/carer, doctor or asthma nurse agrees they are mature enough. Inhalers can be kept in Student Services by prior arrangements with parents/carers.
- Ensures that the whole school environment, including the physical, social, sporting and educational environment, is a favourable to pupils with asthma.
- Recognises that pupils with asthma need immediate access to reliever inhalers at all times.
- At the beginning of each school year or when a child joins the school, parents/carers are asked if their child has any medical conditions including asthma on their enrolment form. The form is then sent out every year to update for monitoring changes.
- Taking part in sports, games and activities is an essential part of school life for all pupils. All teachers know which children in their class have asthma and teachers at the school are aware of which pupils have asthma from the school's asthma register.
- Pupils with asthma are encouraged to participate fully in all PE lessons.

Monitoring and Review
