



Fairtrade Policy

Park Lane Learning Trust is committed to supporting Fairtrade wherever possible.

In particular, we will:

- ensure Fairtrade is part of the School Development Plan;
- use Fairtrade tea, coffee and sugar at all meetings such as governor's meetings, parents' forum, staff meetings and all fund raising and social events;
- promote the use of Fairtrade tea, coffee sugar and other products in the staff room and offices around the school;
- ask Eden catering (or other caterers) to include the use of Fairtrade products wherever possible in catering contracts with our school;
- encourage the food technology department purchases Fairtrade ingredients for any cooking activities;
- encourage the PE department to purchase Fairtrade sports balls when buying new ones;
- ensure Fairtrade is taught as part of appropriate subjects and is included in the experiences and outcomes of our curriculum;
- explore having school uniforms made from Fairtrade cotton;
- promote Fairtrade within the school community, particularly during Fairtrade Fortnight and Family Learning days;
- support the Fairtrade Steering Group in meeting at least once per term

The Steering Group will send a yearly report on 'Fairtrade in the School' to the Fairtrade Foundation in order to maintain our Fairtrade status.

This policy is supported by the Governors, the staff and the students.

Review Framework

This policy will be reviewed every three years.
