All persons employed are required to co-operate with Park Lane Academy to enable all statutory duties to be complied with. The successful implementation of this policy requires total commitment from all persons employed to work at Park Lane Academy.

The allocations of duties for safety matters and the particular arrangements which, will be made to implement the policy are set out in the individual faculty health & safety policies.

The policy will be reviewed annually (or as directed by the Board of Trustees) and updated accordingly, so as to ensure that any changes within the operation of Park Lane Academy and legislation are incorporated into the policy.
